■ **TETANUS-DIPHTHERIA-PERTUSSIS (DPT, DTP, DT, DTaP, Td, Tdap)** –  
**At least 3 doses of diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis containing vaccine are REQUIRED. One dose MUST be Tdap.**  
 The last dose of vaccine (DPT, DTP, DT, DTaP, Td, Tdap) must have been administered within 10 years of the student's enrollment date.

## REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS

As a new student at Trinity Christian College, you are **required** by the state of Illinois to present evidence of immunity against the following: measles, mumps, rubella, tetanus-diphtheria, and meningitis. [**International students** are also **required** to get Tuberculosis Skin Testing – new international students will receive instruction during New International Student Orientation.]

All students are required by the state to present evidence of Immunization History. Vaccinations must be up to date, and forms must be submitted, no later than the following:

**For students enrolling in the Fall Semester: September 1**

**For students enrolling in the Spring Semester: January 10**

**We highly encourage students to submit immunization forms BEFORE the due date;** this will allow the Student Life Office enough time to process your forms and communicate if there is anything that needs to be addressed; this also allows the student time to update any necessary vaccinations **before the due date.**

**Traditional students:** We recommend submitting Immunization records by first day of classes.

**Graduate and Adult Studies:** There will be an opportunity to submit forms at Orientation.

**Please have your medical provider fill out the form on the reverse of this paper.** Students who wish to request vaccination exemptions due to medical or religious reasons should submit a formal, signed exemption request in writing to the Student Services Coordinator.

Because immunizations impact the health of our entire campus community, and because immunization records are required by state law, we take this expectation very seriously. Every admitted student automatically receives an immunization hold on the student's account until immunization records are successfully submitted and approved. Upon completion, the immunization hold will be removed.

**For any student who has not successfully submitted immunization records by the established due date:**

- A \$100.00 non-compliance fee will be charged to the student's account
- **The immunization hold will remain on the student's account until successful submission, preventing registration for future semesters**
- The state will receive a report that you are not in compliance with state immunization law.

**Are there any other consequences for not submitting records of immunization history?** *Yes! In the unlikely event of an outbreak on campus, any student without record of immunizations will be prohibited from campus by the Health Department of the state of Illinois.*

**How can I find my immunization records?** *Most students acquire their immunization records from a doctor, their high school, or most recent college attended.*
